PRIMARY PURPOSE

The Business Analyst provides data and analysis to support optimal company performance by working crossfunctionally to identify and implement changes that will improve company profitability and supporting processes.

- Manage the company's profitability assessment software for purposes of enhancing profitability and improving profitability measurement. Work with company and customer personnel to drive profit improvements.
- Assist CFO in the development, implementation and management of the company's pricing policies and procedures.
- Prepare financial forecasts.
- Identify and implement opportunities to improve our processes and data quality.
- Work with Operations to improve operational performance, including ensuring inventory fulfillment strategy systems and stocking strategies are aligned with company and customer demands.
- Ensure production order costing standards are current and relevant.
