POSITION SUMMARY

PRIMARY FUNCTION

The Engineering Technician, reporting to the Engineering Manager, will be responsible for the maintenance of Assembly Services (AS) Bills of Material (BOMs), Production Routings and Work Instructions. The Engineering Technician will utilize their knowledge of SNC AS products, processes, and documentation requirements to ensure the accuracy, completeness, and clarity of the documentation sent to the manufacturing floor. Additional responsibilities involve working directly with the Manufacturing Technicians to resolve AS manufacturing and test issues real-time, as well as conducting proactive reviews of engineering drawings for manufacturability and accuracy, performing production related time studies, and assisting with other engineering related projects in the office and on the production floor. At all times, the Engineering Technician will look for opportunities to improve manufacturing processes/facilities and report them to the team.
