POSITION SUMMARY

PRIMARY FUNCTION

As a member of the Production Control team, Production Scheduler supports the Assembly Services Team of Swagelok Northern California. This includes the review of customer forecasts for consignment parts, extraction of BOM's and coordination with Supply Chain Management to ensure all materials are ordered and scheduled as needed.

The Production Scheduler is responsible for assisting with the build plan based on material availability. Additionally, working with the Supply Chain Team they assist with expediting materials that are identified on the shortage report. The Production Planner is responsible for review of open order reports, ensuring all components have been ordered, and coordinating allocations of materials.

The position includes responsibility for analyzing prints, specifications, proposals, and other documentation to ensure that orders get processed in an efficient manner. This role requires the ability to prepare clear, complete, and accurate work plans and review detailed drawings along with coordinating fabrication activities to ensure that product conforms to engineering and customer specifications.
